The Arthur County Schools Board of Education met for a special meeting on Monday, April 25, 2016 in the high school library. The purpose of the meeting was to review vendors and approve purchase of new computers or tablets for 2016-17 and review of the budget for the possibility of adding an elementary teacher for 2016-17. The meeting was advertised on the web site, at the Bank of Keystone, US Post Office, Arthur Court House, Wolf Den Market, the school buildings and the Arthur Enterprise. The meeting was called to order at 7:20 p.m. with Andy Bures, Dan Powers, Tom Rut, Ryan Dye, Barry Schaeffer, Terria Hampton, Laura Cooney, Brandee Wilson, Mary Wilson, Dawn Alber, Jason Ohm, Patty Powers, and Trisha Storer present.

Motion made by R. Dye, seconded by D. Powers to approve the agenda. Roll Call Vote was taken. Voting Aye: Ryan Dye, Tom Rut, Dan Powers, Andy Bures. Voting nay: none. Motion carried 4-0.

Mary Wilson gave a presentation to the board of different companies, platforms, and options for updating the computers of the district. Discussion was held on the costs and needs for the district. No decision was made at this time.

Superintendent Barry Schaeffer presented the board with revenue and expenditure figures from the past 5 years and asked to have a meeting with the finance committee consisting of members, Andy Bures, Tom Rut, and Ryan Dye, to discuss where and if cuts could be made in order to allow the hiring of an additional elementary teacher.
