## Kindergarten

Pencil Box (one that can be closed)  
#2 Pencils (sharpened) Please no mechanical pencils  
Erasers (preferably the pencil top kind)  
2 boxes of crayons (8 in box)  
2 boxes of washable Magic Markers  
Scissors (Fiskars are the best)  
10 glue sticks  
3 spiral notebooks  
1 pair of P.E. shoes (to keep at the gym for P.E.)  
1 Water bottle with lid that closes  
Rest mat/blanket and or pillow in a bag for storage. (Could be stored in large plastic grocery bag/trash bag, nothing fancy is needed)
